With help from you the community, we want to make Palmers Green a place that values children as important members of the public, making play accessible to all children and enabling more freedom in their environment.

We are keen to meet local community members and business owners, to find out what you do already, what you want to see more of and what barriers children in your area face.

## Some initial ideas for the project include:

- Winter play sessions for children
- Walking buses to the park (enabling children to visit the park with more freedom)
- Promoting walking and cycling to school
- More play streets set up in the area (including play streets outside schools at the beginning or end of the day)
- Training for retailers and public service providers in child-friendly approaches

We are really excited about this fun and innovative project, but we need your opinions and views!
