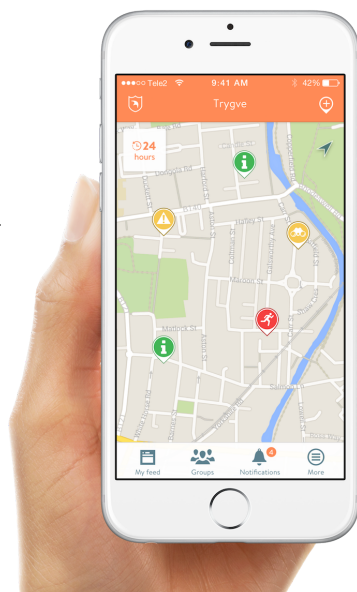
By using **Trygve**, the aim of the pilot is to create a culture where safety and security in Enfield is something we all help increase and enhance together.

## Trygve features

- Incidents ('events') are pinned directly onto a map where users can collaborate.
- Events are categorised and prioritised - higher priority events send alerts to your device
- Users can create and join groups within Trygve to communicate with other users.
- Trygve features a Personal Safety Alarm, which can be easily set to activate on a timer or triggered manually to immediately alert others if a user runs into trouble - great for walks home!
