

Palmers Green Safer Neighbourhood Team News

The next few days have been forecasted as being exceptionally warm for this country. Please if you have elderly neighbours check in on them to make sure they are well and don't need anything. Stay safe and stay hydrated.

Thankfully in the month of June motor vehicle crime went back down again. Please if you are able check your vehicle is locked before you walk away as the majority of thieves walk the streets trying door handles overnight until they find a car unlocked.



We successfully applied for a warrant for an address on Hedge Lane after receiving information from the public and officers. On executing the warrant some offensive weapons were found and seized. We also assisted Southgate Green SNT with the execution of a warrant on Morton Way where a large amount of mature plants and dried cannabis was found and seized. Thankfully not making its way to our streets.

A few weekends ago we spent the afternoon patrolling Broomfield Park during an event held. Lovely afternoon speaking to park users and getting to know the park again which will soon be part of Palmers Green ward.

Many of you may be aware that the electoral wards in Enfield have changed since the local elections in May. This has added or changed the name of five wards. So in the coming months we will also be changing to police these new wards and there are some significant changes.

Palmers Green new electoral ward has moved north-west to take Broomfield Park and Fox Lane, up to and including Conway Road and Crothall Close. We lose everything below the New River except Oakthorpe Road. These roads will be a new ward called Highfield which will cover what was the bottom of the ward and include some of Winchmore Hill Ward and Firs Farm wetlands.

We will let you know when we change to police the new wards, their contact details and areas.

Crimes Recorded this month

There were 121 reported allegations of crime on Palmers Green Ward during this period.

Burglary

There were 3 residential burglaries and 1 attempted residential burglary during June.

HEDGE LANE, between 5pm and 11pm on 3rd June. Front door has been forced open to gain entry. House has been searched through and jewellery and envelopes containing money were taken.

PARK AVENUE, on 10th June at 11.50pm. An unknown person has climbed up on to a rear extension from Kingsley Road and attempted to open a first floor window making some noise. Then tried a second window in the corner and was about to climb through when they were challenged by the owner. They then jumped off the roof and drove off in a black car.

GREEN LANES, on 16th June at 4pm. The bike storage room in a block has been entered and a locked bike taken from the bike rack. Unknown how entry was gained through door which requires a fob to open it.

Motor Vehicle Crime

There were 9 thefts from motor vehicles and 6 thefts of motor vehicles reported in June.

GREEN LANES, between 1.05pm and 2.30pm on 1st June. Car was entered and jewellery left in the car was taken.

Victim's bike helmet was found discarded on the floor.

PALMERSTON CRESCENT, between 2pm and 3pm on 14th June. Flat door was forced open. Appears nothing was taken but the room looks like it has been lived in by an unknown person during the victim's absence.

Please remember to double lock your front doors whether you have a UPVC door or have a Yale and mortice. If you also have a UPVC porch door then double lock that too. If you have the security installed, then please use it.

Please also consider the use of timer switches to light your houses up after dark if you are not yet home.



PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOUBLE LOCKING A UPVC (THREE OR FIVE POINT LOCKING SYSTEM) DOOR.

If a UPVC door is not locked with a key the door handle goes down when tried and is left very weakly secure with a very small piece of triangular metal going into the frame. This point on the doorframe near the lock is where the suspects target with their screwdrivers or crowbars and can pop your door open sometimes with very little effort

ASH GROVE, on 2nd June at 12.20am. Catalytic converter taken from vehicle.

FELSTEAD CLOSE, between 5pm, 2nd June and 9am, 3rd June. Catalytic converter was taken from 2010 BMW.

ALDERMANS HILL, on 8th June at 11am. A hole was drilled in the side door of a van and tools were taken.

CONNAUGHT GARDENS, between 1.10pm and 1.12pm on 9th June. Catalytic converter taken from a 2003 Mazda.

SHAPLAND WAY, between 7pm, 10th June and 9am, 11th June. A 2004 Fiat Punto was taken from the location.

MUNSTER GARDENS, between 12.01am and 5.30am on 13th June. Vehicle was entered and some cash due to be banked was taken.

BROOMFIELD AVENUE, on 13th June at 12.16am. A 2018 Lexus was taken from the location possibly via relay attack as keyless and keys were not taken.

HAZELWOOD LANE, between 7pm, 15th June and 6am, 16th June. A 2020 Suzuki motorbike was taken from the location.

NORTH CIRCULAR ROAD, between 1pm, 8th June and 12pm, 16th June. A car was not returned at the end of the hire period and could not be found at the hirer's given address. Car has since been stopped and seized by police.

ALDERMANS HILL, between 11.15am and 11.35am, 20th June. A catalytic converter was taken from a 2005 Honda CRV.

ALDERMANS HILL, between 11am and 11.15am, 21st June. Suspects have drilled into the victim's vehicle to gain entry and take work tools.

PARKSIDE TERRACE, between 6am and 6.05am, 24th June. A 2017 Mercedes tipper lorry was taken from the location.

ALDERMANS HILL, on 24th June on 9.30am. Number plates were taken from vehicle.

GREEN LANES, between 1am and 8.20am, 28th June. A 2013 Honda motorbike was taken from the location.

Robbery and personal theft

There was 1 robbery and 5 personal thefts reported during the past month.

NEW RIVER CRESCENT, on 4th June at 11.40pm. Victim was chased by three suspects who exited a car and beat him up before they searched him searched for his phone which they

did not find as he wasn't carrying one. They then got back in their car and drove off.

GREEN LANES, between 1pm and 2pm on 30th May. The victim went to a shop and then a coffee shop before entering a charity shop. When the victim went to pay their wallet was not in their bag. £50 in cash was in the wallet. Cards were not used.

GREEN LANES, between 5.50pm and 6.02pm on 4th June. The victim got out of her car with her phone in her hand and walking to the shops when a male snatched her phone from her hand as he went past on his bicycle and then cycled away.

GREEN LANES, on 9th June at 12.15pm. The victim was waiting at a bus stop and someone went past on a scooter and snatched her phone out of her hand.

GREEN LANES, on 14th June at 8.25am. A moped mounted the pavement and the passenger snatched the victim's phone from her hand. As she was wearing ear pods and was on the phone she shouted they'd taken her phone. This appeared to make the passenger turn around and throw the phone into the road before the moped was driven off towards the A406.

GREEN LANES, on 27th June at 5.05pm. A female suspect took the victim's phone from her pocket while she was distracted in a shop.
