Please have a look into whether your car was fitted with a tracker when manufactured and whether it is active. If it didn't have one built in look into purchasing one and also a ghost immobiliser.

Crimes Recorded this month

There were 131 reported allegations of crime on Palmers Green Ward during this period.

Burglary

There was 1 residential burglary during August.

ELMDALE ROAD, on 29th August between 6pm and 6.05pm. Unknown suspect has entered the rear garden via an unlocked side gate and climbed through an open ground floor window and taken a set of house keys. The suspect has possibly left the same way.

Motor Vehicle Crime

There were 8 thefts from motor vehicles and 5 thefts of motor vehicles reported in August.

ELMDALE ROAD, on 2nd August, 12.01-7am. Number plates were taken from a vehicle.

THE GROVE, on 4th August, 7-8pm. Vehicle window was smashed and a blue badge was taken.


ALDERMANS HILL, on 8th August, 11.30-11.37am. Catalytic converter was taken from a Lexus parked on Broomfield Avenue.

SHAPLAND WAY, on 9th August, 11am-4pm. A van was entered and a bag containing personal items, a laptop and a speaker were taken.

DEVONSHIRE, between 11.59pm, 9th August and 1am, 10th August. A 2017 Hyundai Ioniq was taken from the location without keys.

Please remember to double lock your front doors whether you have a UPVC door or have a Yale and mortice. If you also have a UPVC porch door then double lock that too. If you have the security installed, then please use it.

Please also consider the use of timer switches to light your houses up after dark if you are not yet home.



PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOUBLE LOCKING A UPVC (THREE OR FIVE POINT LOCKING SYSTEM) DOOR.

If a UPVC door is not locked with a key the door handle goes down when tried and is left very weakly secure with a very small piece of triangular metal going into the frame. This point on the doorframe near the lock is where the suspects target with their screwdrivers or crowbars and can pop your door open sometimes with very little effort

HAMILTON CRESCENT, on 10th August, 3-3.30am. A van was entered via the side door and items were taken.

ALDERMANS HILL, on 11th August, 11.10am-1pm. A catalytic converter was taken from a Honda Jazz.

RIVERWAY, on 18th August, 3.08-4.08am. A 2021 Toyota Rav 4 was taken from the location without keys.

LIGHTCLIFFE ROAD, on 22nd August, 1.45-2.30pm. A catalytic converter was taken from a Mazda MX5.

BRIDGE DRIVE, BROOMFIELD LANE, on 25th August, 9.45-10.10am. A van was entered and power tools were taken from the rear. Van was possibly left insecure.

HAZELWOOD LANE, on 24th August, 1030pm. A car was entered on the victim's driveway and

Robbery and personal theft

The victim followed the suspected and asked for his glasses back and the suspect threw them to the floor. The victim followed the suspect was arrested on Aldermans Hill. Investigation is ongoing.

BROOMFIELD PARK, ALDERMANS HILL, on 3rd August, 2.50pm. The victim was walking along the road when he noticed the suspect staring at him and then approaching him. The suspect grabbed the victim's glasses off his face causes scratches and then broke the glasses' frame and threw them to the floor. The suspect then walked into the park and away after saying to the victim what are you going to do about it.




Check these locations:

Many people we visit are asking for ID when we visit them. However, would you know what a real Met Police warrant card looks like?

The one **BELOW** is the real one. Check for the hologram on the warrant card (front and rear), and the signature of the Commissioner NOT the holder.
