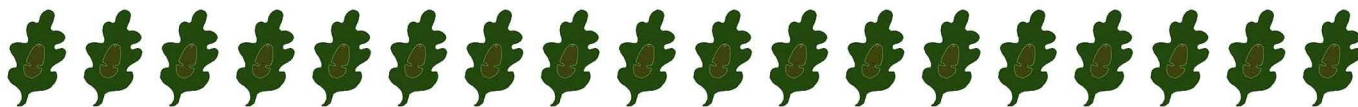


Southgate Civic Week

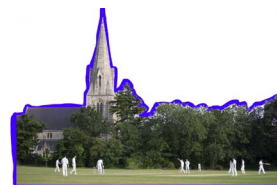
